



Courses

- Offered at the High School by HS teachers
- Have option to enroll at a University / College and earn college credit
- Students must pay for college fees, some districts may have scholarships or special funds

- English

- Social sciences / Humanities / Psychology

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

Courses

- Offered at High School by HS Teachers
- Students take a national standardized test
- Test will determine the grade
- Universities and Colleges across the US have rules for acceptance
 - Based on grades and type of course
 - May be taken for full credit towards major, credit as electives, or for placement only

DIRECT ENROLLMENT

Enroll at a University or College while in High School

Must follow the process of the institution, many allow non-degree seeking students

Provide University/College pace and rigor

Summer courses are a good option

Kansas provides free enrollment for Excel in CTE courses for HS students
